# Annual Conference

This is DCN's flagship event, attended by up to 300 senior officers and politicians from member councils.

It attracts high profile speakers, who in recent years have included Rishi Sunak, public health expert Professor Jonathan Van-Tam and TV host Steph McGovern.

It provides a unique forum for central government and district councils to interact about the issues that matter most to the most local tier of principal local government.

2025's event takes place on 13-14 March. We have a new location – the enchanting De Vere Beaumont Estate in Old Windsor – which is large enough to accommodate all delegates on site.

Appropriately the DCN Conference's new home is a stone's throw away from the birthplace of UK democracy – Runnymede. The estate features an 18th century mansion, a state-of-the art conference centre and 42 acres of parkland. It's just minutes from Junction 13 of the M25 and a mere three miles from Egham station, with fast connections to London Waterloo and Reading.







DCN's Annual Conference features a mix of discussion on the biggest issues of the day and ample opportunity for networking and socialising.

There will be prominent keynote speakers, with ministers and leading Opposition figures expected to appear, as well as panel discussions, all offering plenty of opportunity for delegates to interact with our speakers.

At a number of our plenary and breakout sessions DCN partner speakers gain an opportunity to speak alongside some of the biggest names in local government, offering their thoughts and visions.

We offer an array of conference options, most of which offer full access for two attendees from your organisations to all conference sessions (apart from the few sessions which are politically restricted). The one exception is the Networker package, each of which offers access for one person.
